VARIETY	Comments
'Acoma'	Pure white. Med. growth to about 10' with equal spread. Interesting spreading habit, almost weeping. <i>Recommended</i> .
'Biloxi'	Delicate pale pink. Orange-red fall color. Recommended.
'Catawba'	Dark purple, to 15'. Orange-red fall color. Mildew resistance good. <i>Recommended</i> .
'Centennial Spirit'	Dark pink/red, to 10'. Slow grower. Mildew resistance good. <i>Recommended.</i>
'Cherokee'	Bright red/pink, to 10'. Yellow fall color. Mildew resistance good. <i>Recommended</i> .
'Compact Orchid'	Lavender-pink. Slow growth to 10'; easily kept to 4'.
'Compact Pink'	Pink. Slow growth to 10'; easily kept to 4'.
'Durant's Red'	Dark pink. Mod. growth to 15'. Mildew resistance fair. Orange-red fall color. 'Grey's Red' is very similar.
'Dynamite'	Cherry red to 15' tall. Color varies with temperature. Orange fall color. <i>Recommended</i> .
'Firebird'	Dark pink/red, to 20'. Mildew resistance good. Recommended.
'Hopi'	Medium pink. Slow growth to +/- 10'; easily kept lower. Mildew resistance good. <i>Recommended</i> .
'Majestic Orchid'	Orchid-lavender. Med. growth to 15'+. Orange-red fall color. Mildew resistance good. <i>Recommended</i> .
'Miami'	Medium pink, like 'Watermelon Red'. Grows to about 20'; can be kept smaller. Mildew resistance high. <i>Recommended</i> .
'Muskogee'	Pink-lavender. Fast to 25', with large leaves. Orange-red fall color. Mildew resistance very high. <i>Highly recommended!</i>
'Natchez'	Pure white. Very fast growth to 25 - 30'. One of the biggest and best Crepe myrtles! Bright yellow fall color, beautiful bark. Mildew resistance very high. <i>Highly recommended!</i>
'Okmulgee'	Very slow grower to 6', easily kept lower. Dark pink ('red'). <i>Recommended</i> .

'Orchid'	Light lavender. Orange-red fall color. Good mildew resistance. <i>Recommended</i> .
'Pecos'	Medium pink. Slow growth to +/- 10'; easily kept lower. Orange-maroon fall color. Mildew resistance high. <i>Highly recommended!</i>
'Peppermint Lace'	Dark pink with white edges. Slow to 10'. Mildew resistance good. <i>Recommended</i> .
'Petite Embers'	Deep pink, compact. Slow to 10'. Easily kept to 3 - 4'. Mildew resistance good. <i>Recommended</i> .
'Petite Orchid'	Lavender-pink. Slow to 10'. Easily kept to 3 - 4'. Also called 'Compact Orchid'.

'Petite Pink'	Medium pink. Slow to 10'. Easily kept to 3 - 4'. Also called 'Compact Pink', 'Petite Pinkie'. Mildew resistance good. <i>Recommended</i> .
'Petite White'	White. Slow growth to 10'. Easily kept to 3 - 4'. Mildew resistance good. <i>Recommended</i> .
'Pokomoke'	Pink. Very dwarf to 2' tall and wide.
'Purple'	Purple. Med. growth rate to 15'. Mildew resistance fair.
'Red Rocket'	Red. Color varies with temperature. Fast to 30'. <i>Recommended</i> .
'Regal Red'	Dark red/pink, med. growth to 15'. Color varies with temperature. Good mildew resistance. <i>Recommended</i> .
'Rubra'	Dark pink, med. growth to 20'+. Mildew resistance fair.
'Rubra Compacta'	Dark red/pink with yellow stamens. Slow growth to 6'+, easily kept to 4'. <i>Recommended</i> .
'Seminole'	Pink. Med. growth to 12'. Good mildew resistance. Recommended.
'Tuscarora'	Bright coral pink. Very fast growth to 25'. Large leaves. Orange-red fall color. Mildew resistance very high. <i>Highly recommended!</i>
'Tuskegee'	Dark pink. Spreading habit. 15' tall and wide. <i>Recommended</i> .
'Watermelon Red'	The standard medium pink Crepe myrtle. Mod. growth to 15'. Mildew resistance fair. See 'Miami'.
'Zuni'	Dark lavender. Slow growth to +/- 10'; easily kept lower. Orange-red to maroon fall color. Mildew resistance high. <i>Highly recommended!</i>
