Common name	Botanical name	Comments
Coral tree	Erythrina	E. crista-galli can grow as a large perennial
Figs, ornamental	Ficus benjamina, F. nitida	to zone 13
Floss-silk tree	Chorisia	to zone 12
Frangipani	Plumeria	frost-tender
Gold medallion tree	Cassia leptophylla	to zone 15; other Cassias are even more tender
Hibiscus, Chinese	Hibiscus rosa-sinensis	marginal here
Jasmine, Arabian (true, aka Pikake)	Jasminum sambac	to zone 13
Mandevilla	Mandevilla	to zone 21
Orchid tree	Bauhinia	most to about zone 18
Princess flower	Tibouchina urvilleana	to zone 16
Ti plant	Cordyline fruticosa	to zone 21
